SECTION A. Project Title: Enhancement of Material Characterization Capabilities at North Carolina State University for Supporting Nuclear Energy Related Studies – North Carolina State University
SECTION B. Project Description
North Carolina State University proposes to acquire a high spatial resolution photoluminescence and Raman spectroscopy and mapping system to characterize nuclear fuel, cladding materials and nuclear sensor materials along with a floating zone furnace and accessories for sample preparation and thermal treatment. The equipment will be used for research related to nuclear science and engineering programs of interest to the DOE NE R&D mission and the education and training of graduate and undergraduate students of nuclear engineering.

The action would not create additional environmental impacts above those already occurring at the university.
