SECTION B. Project Description
The project objective is to increase the research, teaching, and education capabilities of the Walthousen Reactor Critical Facility at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute. A pulsed neutron source will be inserted into the core of the reactor. Additionally, RPI will acquire 2 DAQ computers, two IPads, four pico-ampere meters, and key parts of the control rod drive and water flow system will be replaced.

The action consists of funding the purchase of additional pieces of equipment and instruments that the university all ready uses for an existing program. The work related to the reactor is covered by RPI's NRC license.
